

SUBJ : Yearly Response to Resistance Report

Upon reviewing the IAPRO Response to Resistance Reports for the year 2019 we had (13) Response to Resistance reports involving (22) Hewitt Officers. Of the (13) reports all were found to be within policy.

Two officers were injured during the 2019 year. One was shot in the shoulder during a Robbery in February. The second officer injured his foot during a foot pursuit in April.

Two suspects were taken to the hospital and treated and released due to crashing during pursuits and later Response to Resistance when they were taken down at gunpoint.

Of the Response to Resistance reports only one case, the Robbery, involved a firearm.

The majority of cases were Empty Soft Hand Control, (6), and were effective. The second two cases involved Firearm exhibited and Firearm pointed at subject, (one each). Both were effective.
