 - A Solicitor is not to return to a private premise to solicit when the person has already attempted to solicit at the location and has been told by the owner or occupant that they are not interested.
 - No solicitation at a private premise where there is posted a sign or placard communicating that the owner or occupant does not want to be solicited, such as "No Solicitors", "No Solicitation", "Keep Out" or which otherwise purports to indicate that solicitation is unwelcome, unless the person has been invited upon the premises by the owner or occupant of the premises.
